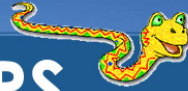

A great range of tours that are educational, cultural tours of the Margaret River region with an emphasis on fun! Tours can be designed to suit any school needs or requirements.

Bushtucker Cave & Canoe Tour – This tour can be altered to suit requirements and time constraints. From 2 hours, 2.4 hours, up to 3 hour options. Tour includes canoeing down the calm waters of the Margaret River, learning plant knowledge, local history and wild life identification. An optional cave adventure is included. Hearty wild food lunch with Roo, Emu, Witjiti grubs and breads; or basic bush food tastings of vegetables and fruits can also be arranged. Prices start at \$15 for one hour trip, to \$35 per child for canoe & cave bushtucker lunch with heritage and cultural guide.

Bushtucker Great Karri Walk – From 2 – 3 hours. Children will walk the ancient forest by the Margaret River. Learn plant species and medicinal properties of the local flora. Taste up to 20 wild, native foods, some of these includes bush tomatoes, desert limes, bunya nuts and even the yummy witjiti grub! Prices start from \$12 per child.

Bushtucker Tour Guides hold current first aid and Bronze Medallion certificates. Copies of Public Liability, First Aid and Bronze Medallion certificate / documents are available if required. Tours can be planned to run sequentially for group needs.
